- Heb 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

- Pet 1:17 If you say 'Father' to him who judges everyone impartially on the basis of what they have done, you must live in awe of him during your time on earth.
- 1 Esd 4:39f "There is no favouritism with her, no partiality; rather she exacts justice from everyone who is wicked or unjust. All approve what she does;
- 1 Tim 2:4 whose will it is that all should find salvation and come to know the truth.
